

The Mad River Township Trustees met in regular session Monday March 18, 2013. Trustee McClure called the meeting to order at 7:36 pm. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silence for Donnie Nelson, Commander at the VFW.

Fiscal Officer Leonard read the minutes from the March 4, 2013 meeting, approved as read, motion by Trustee Estep, seconded by Trustee Catanzaro, all trustees voting yes.

Reports:

Don O'Connor – Road and Cemetery - Went over his report provided to the Trustees. Don and Doug discussed the quote for the geo-probing in the cemetery. Trustee Catanzaro asked about the truck bid – Don is working on calls to a few other companies.

Chief Leist – Enon Fire and EMS – Dave has two applicants here this evening and he would like to move forward on the two individuals. Devin Adams is a paramedic that also works at WS Electronics. Devin provided a little background information about himself and his interest in the township dept. William Green is level II Firefighter and instructor and was previous military. He is also a diesel mechanic. His EMS card has expired but they are working on getting that retested.

Dave would like to send condolences to the Nelson family. Dave would like to emphasize that the tornado sirens are intended for those individuals outdoors. When you hear the siren, you should check your local media to see what is going on and take appropriate action.

A discussion ensued on the new medic and the committee is scheduled to meet the 28th.

Hustead EMS – Officer Scott Kaufman – Reiterate condolences to the Nelson family. They attended the Phyllis Duncan service which was much appreciated by the family. They are currently working with their medical director and protocol testing.


