

The Mad River Township Trustees met in regular session Monday April 16, 2012. Mr. Catanzaro called the meeting to order at 7:33 pm. Trustees McClure, Estep, and Catanzaro were in attendance, Fiscal Officer Leonard present. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Fiscal Officer Leonard read the minutes from the March 19 meeting and the April 2 meeting. Trustee Estep motioned to amend the March 19 minutes. Trustee McClure motioned to approve the March 19 minutes and the April 2 minutes, seconded by Mrs. Estep, all trustees voting yes.

Reports:

Chief Young – nothing to report, just has some invoices for the clerk.

Chief Leist – has a contract with Medicount to sign, Mr. McClure would like to wait until our Friday meeting with Medicount to sign the contract.

There is a table top exercise tomorrow; we are required to take part of these exercises to obtain grants. This is typically a haz-mat incident.

Don O'Connor – Roads and Cemetery – Deputy Wagoner is down at Lindair Acres Crime Watch Meeting. They are trying to get ahead on road mowing. Don met with Hensley's last week to get repair estimates on the areas noted during the drive around. On Thurs. May 3, Doug and Don will be going down to a pipeline safety course. This is put on in the area every few years.

Cemetery foundations are being poured. They would like to get them ready by April 30. The stones can be set then whenever they come in. They are going to start spraying the cemetery for weeds tomorrow. There have been quite a few funerals lately.

They will have time to get the park painted.

Trustee Catanzaro stated in regards to the railroad crossing that the railroad said they would not fix the spot. PUCO stated they were not going to intervene. This will have to be looked into more.

Old Business – The Dayton Road parking ban resolution needs to be amended and a second reading done. The resolution will prohibit parking on both sides of the county road from the Greene County line to Haddix Road. Trustee Estep read the second reading:

**IN THE MATTER OF ESTABLISHING  
PARKING REGULATIONS PURSUANT TO R.C. 505.17:**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Mad River Township, Clark County, Ohio has determined the public safety and welfare would be served by the establishment of a parking ban on County Road 333, Dayton-Springfield Road, between the Greene County line and Haddix Road; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 505.17 enables a township board of trustees to adopt parking regulations within the jurisdiction of the township;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Mad River Township;

I. Pursuant to R.C. 505.17(A), the following parking regulation is hereby established:

Parking shall be prohibited on both sides of County Road 333, Dayton-Springfield Road, between the Greene County line and Haddix Road.

II. The Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to post the regulations in five conspicuous public places in the Township for thirty days before this parking ban will become effective and cause the same to be published for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township.

III. The regulation shall become effective upon completion of the posting and newspaper publication, and upon posting signs giving notice of the regulation in accordance with R.C. 4511.09.

IV. In conformance with R.C. 505.17(E), a violation of this resolution will be handled pursuant to Chapter 4521 of the Ohio Revised Code. A violation of this resolution shall not be considered a criminal offense for any purpose, and a person that violates this resolution shall not be arrested as a result of the commission of the violation.

V. A violation of this resolution will result in a fine of \$100.

VI. Pursuant to R.C. 4521.02, any vehicle found standing or parked in violation of this resolution is subject to impoundment or immobilization.

Mr. Catanzaro motioned to accept the second reading, seconded by Mr. McClure, all trustees voting yes.

Mr. McClure stated that Chief Leist is setting up a meeting with Medicount Management on Friday morning pending a representative from Green Township being present.

New Business:

Trustee Estep asked about the trash can at the park. Don stated that they have put a new one in.

Trustee McClure would like to motion to hire Robert Branam, part time at \$10.00 on a probationary status for 90 days, seconded by Mrs. Estep, all trustees voting yes.

Trustee Estep received a letter from the Ohio Cemetery Association welcoming us to the association.

Mr. McClure passed along some grass complaints to Deputy Wagoner. Mr. Catanzaro asked about the cruiser. The transmission is showing signs of wear. We have been discussing whether it would be more prudent to fix the cruiser or replace it.
