Regular Session – October 17, 2016

The Mad River Township Trustees met in regular session Monday, October 17, 2016.

Present: Trustees Bob McClure, Kathy Estep and Joe Catanzaro. Fiscal Officer David Rudy was not present.

Trustee McClure called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and a welcome to the audience members in attendance.
