Under Old Business the Trustees followed up on the complaint of rabbits on Hahn Avenue. The complainant felt the problem was moving towards resolution. Bids were received for the fencing in Porter Park of \$1100. The cost to replace the cemetery fence will be \$300.

Under New Business the Trustees reported that Charlie Swaney had met with the County Engineer and the Rocky Point Bridge repairs hopefully will be paid for with grant money. The next phase of the Green Meadows road work will include Arnold drive, Green Meadows Drive and Otis Drive at an approximate cost of \$160,000.

Pam Thompson questioned the Trustees on how to obtain information about possible rezoning issues. A Schenley Drive resident asked the Trustees to look in to the damage to the road caused when a water main broke. Cheryl Smith questioned the Trustees about the Crossroads Land Use Plan.
