The Trustees of Mad River Township met in regular session with Richard Schumann, Robert McClure and Kathy Estep, Trustees, and Debra Maurer, Clerk present. Motion by Mrs. Estep, seconded by Mr. McClure to approve the minutes of the meeting held 4-3-06 as read. All Trustees present voting aye.

Chief Leist presented the first quarter report. The number of fire runs is down.

Chief Richards reported that the new flag pole and sign are installed. A discussion was held on the pros and cons of updating or replacing the Capnography units. It was decided to replace the units for both departments.

Chief Young reported that the department had staged a successful training including a practice burn.

Deputy Wagner reported that the Enon Messenger article about removing unlicensed cars from the streets was helpful.

Under Old Business the Community Clean-Up Day is May 6.

Under New Business the Trustees are still waiting for estimates for the Porter Park fencing. A meeting was held with the Enon Community Historical Society about building a storage facility on township property. Hahn Avenue residents addressed the trustees with concerns about rabbits being raised on a neighbor's property. They have already contacted a number of agencies and no one seems to be able to help them. Mr. Schumann will contact Kelly Daniels to try to get some information. The situation appears to be a business and could possibly be a zoning issue.

Mr. Donaldson inquired if it would be possible for Husted Fire and EMS to present a quarterly report. Chief Richards will bring information to the next meeting.

There being no further business, Mr. McClure moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mrs. Estep. All Trustees present voting aye.
